#### REPORTABLE TRAUMA

The following charts show data for 2019-2022 Trauma cases that met the TSE reportable criteria.

#### **DEFINITIONS**

Mode of Arrival: Count of patients transported to facility via EMS (i.e. fixedwing, ground, or helicopter ambulance), Walk-In (i.e. private or public vehicle), or transferred in from another facility.


CAH & Comm. Care ED Length of Stay: Time from arrival to ED discharge for patients with an ED disposition of "11" (i.e. transferred to another hospital).

**Tertiary ED Length of Stay**: Time from arrival to ED discharge (i.e. inpatient unit).


**Arrival to DC Order Written:** Time from ED arrival to orders written to discharge.

ED Length of Stay by ISS: Time from arrival to ED discharge for patients with an ED disposition of "11" (i.e. transferred to another hospital). Grouped by Injury Severity Score.




## TERTIARY - VOLUME BY MODE OF ARRIVAL

#### **DEFINITIONS**


**Volume**: Total number of patients with eligible ICD-10-CM trauma codes.

Motor Vehicle Non-public Roads: A vehicle accident that occurs entirely in any place other than the public highway or street (i.e. a private ranch).

**Mechanism of Injury:** The vector that transfers the energy to the body (e.g. fall, motor vehicle traffic accident, or poisoning).


### 2022 ED LENGTH OF STAY BY ISS


MEDIAN TIME IN MINUTES

#### REPORTABLE STROKE

The following charts show data for 2019-2022 Stroke cases that met the TSE reportable criteria.

#### **DEFINITIONS**

**Volume by Arrival**: Count of patients transported to facility via EMS (i.e. fixedwing, ground, or helicopter ambulance) or Walk-In (i.e. private or public vehicle).

**Door-to-Brain Image**: Time from arrival at ED to brain imaging.


**Door-to-Brain Image Read**: Time from arrival at ED to read out of brain imaging results.

**Door-to-thrombolytics**: Time from arrival at ED at thrombolytics administration.


**Door-to-IA Cath**: Time from arrival at ED to IA catheter placement.

**Volume**: Total number of patients with eligible ICD-10-CM stroke codes.


### **CAH - VOLUME BY MODE OF ARRIVAL**



## COMM. CARE - VOLUME BY MODE OF ARRIVAL




## TERTIARY - VOLUME BY MODE OF ARRIVAL






### DOOR-TO-BRAIN IMAGE (GOAL <20)

## **DOOR-TO-BRAIN IMAGE READ** (GOAL <45) MEDIAN TIME IN MINUTES








#### REPORTABLE STEMI

The following charts show data for 2020-2022 STEMI cases that met the TSE reportable criteria.

#### **DEFINITIONS**


**Mode of Arrival**: Count of patients transported to facility via EMS (i.e. fixedwing, ground, or helicopter ambulance) or Walk-In (i.e. private or public vehicle).

**Door-to-ECG**: Time from arrival to ECG for ECGs that occur post arrival, i.e. not in the field.


**Door-to-Door-to-Device**: Time from arrival at first facility ED to device activation at second facility among patients transferred from one facility to another.

**Door-to-Device:** Time from arrival in ED or hospital (direct to cath lab) to device activation among "walk-in" patients (arrive via non-transferring ambulance or private vehicle).


## REFERRAL CENTERS - VOLUME BY MODE OF ARRIVAL

#### **DEFINITIONS**

**FMC-to-Device Transfers**: Time from first medical contact (EMS or ED arrival) to device activation time among patients who are transferred in from another facility.

FMC-to-Device Non-Transfers: Time from first medical contact (EMS or ED arrival) to device activation time among patients who arrive directly to the treating facility via private vehicle or EMS (direct arrivals/non-transfer patients).


Symptom Onset-to-Device Transfers: Time from symptom onset to device activation among patients transferred between facilities.

Symptom Onset-to-Device Non-Transfers: Time from symptom onset to device activation among patients arriving via private vehicle or EMS (nontransfer).


**Volume:** Total number of patients with eligible ICD-10-CM STEMI codes.


MEDIAN TIME IN MINUTES (GOAL <10)




### DOOR-TO-DOOR-TO-DEVICE TRANSFERS MEDIAN TIME IN MINUTES (GOAL < 120)



### **DOOR-TO-DEVICE NON-TRANSFERS**MEDIAN TIME IN MINUTES (GOAL <90)








### 2022 SYMPTOM ONSET-TO-DEVICE
